Andy Bear Club is a 2-day early childhood group program which aims to meet the individual needs of each child and their family. The program emulates typical daycare experiences, presented in a structured and predictable way to support the engagement and learning of all children across the program.

Objectives

- Engaging and participating in the routines of a structured learning environment in preparation for the transition to school.
- Building independence across all aspects of daily living, e.g., toileting, managing self and belonging, mealtimes, etc.
- Developing functional play skills across a broad range of age-appropriate play experiences.
- Developing solid relationships as a platform for building social engagement with both adults and peers.

Who should attend this program?

This group is open to children of all abilities, from 3 –5 years of age.
