# Transition to School



This is a week long intensive program for children with a developmental disability who commencing a formal school placement in 2026. The group program focuses on supporting the children in preparation for their transition to kindergarten. Opt in for one week or both.

### Who should attend this program?

A child who has a diagnosed developmental disability and will be attending formal schooling in 2026

#### **Objectives**

- Becoming familiar with wearing school uniform and independently managing belongings.
- Relating to others in structured and semi structured experiences.
- · Developing classroom skills, e.g. following instructions from the teacher, completing and moving between tasks with minimal prompting, and working cooperatively with others.

• Working independently during table-based experiences, as well as, in small and whole group experiences. Understanding and responding to school routines, e.g. arrival, departure, 'bell times', meals and play.
