

Transition to School



This is a week long intensive program for children with a diagnosed developmental disability who will be commencing a formal school placement in 2026. The group program focuses on supporting the children in preparation for their transition to kindergarten. Opt in for one week or both.

Who should attend this program?

A child who has a diagnosed developmental disability and will be attending formal schooling in 2026

Objectives

- Becoming familiar with wearing school uniform and independently managing belongings.
- Relating to others in structured and semi structured experiences.
- Developing classroom skills, e.g. following instructions from the teacher, completing and moving between tasks with minimal prompting, and working cooperatively with others.
- Working independently during table-based experiences, as well as, in small and whole group experiences. Understanding and responding to school routines, e.g. arrival, departure, 'bell times', meals and play.

When / Where is the program?

- Mon 19th to Thurs 22nd January (4 days)
- Tues 27th to 30st January (4 days)

This group is facilitated by one of our therapists and is supported by therapy assistants.
